The Sudan Interior Mission is the outgrowth of the first missionary expedition in 1893 into interior Nigeria under the leadership of Dr. Rowland V. Bingham.

Over 1200 missionaries now serve the Lord in Africa and Arabia under the S.I.M. in about 200 stations in the countries of Nigeria, French West Africa, Ethiopia, Sudan, Aden, Dahomey, Liberia, Eritrea, and Somalia.

The greatest emphasis has always been placed upon evangelism and that all other means are secondary.

The Lord has blessed the work of our Bible Schools, Leprosaria, Orphanages, Hospitals, Dispensaries, the Niger Press, the African Challenge, other Christian publications, the African Missionary Society, and our 50,000 watt radio station E. L. W. A. in Liberia, and the aviation ministry to win additional souls for His kingdom.

The Sudan Interior Mission is evangelical in its doctrinal position, and it sends forth consecrated workers from any church, sound in the fundamental truths of the Bible.
